- Community gatherings and cultural events

- Food preparation and serving
- Preparing materials and supplies for workshops and programs
- Other projects that support the ongoing care and development of the Q Healing land

General volunteers do not need specialized experience. We welcome people who are willing to help, learn, work respectfully with others, and contribute to a welcoming environment for Elders, Knowledge Keepers, families, youth, and community members.
